In May 2009, John was diagnosed with prostate cancer, and spent the summer undergoing radiation treatment for that. He was also injected at 6-month intervals a hormone inhibitor which has a few side effects; one of which is hot flashes. I'm guessing he has lots of sympathy from the women. Lots of scans and tests go along with this diagnosis. One such scan revealed a large abdominal aneurysm on his aorta close to where it goes into the kidneys. We were alarmed because nothing could be done until he completed radiation therapy plus giving his body some time to recover. Surgery was finally scheduled, and on April 13th of this year, John underwent the procedure at the Oklahoma Heart Hospital in OKC that would correct his aneurysm. Can't say enough about the staff there; they are skilled and diligent. After a week, we came home to Perkins, and John is in recuperating mode. He is having some problems with fatigue and appetite—some days even chocolate tastes bad. His surgeon said these were the big two complaints he got from patients having undergone this type operation.

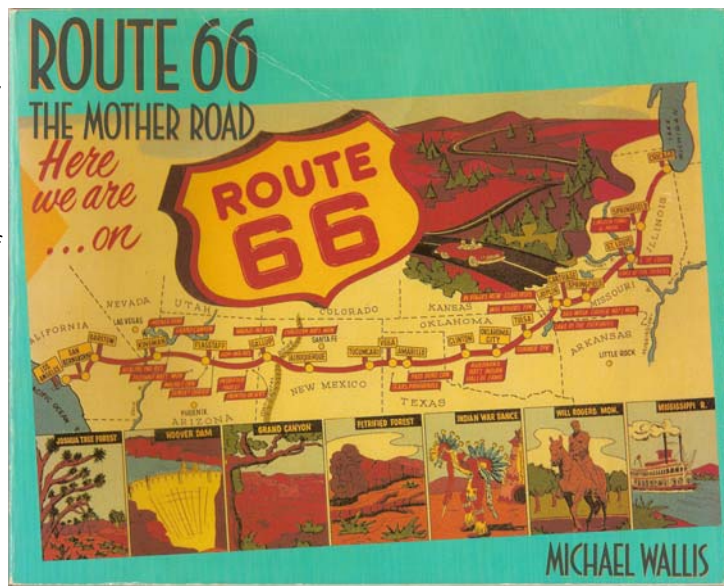

On June 5, 2010, all parties who are joining us will meet at Braum's at I-35 & 15th Street in Edmond (exit # 140) at 8:30 am to leave at 9:00 am heading east on Route 66 to Chicago. We will cover 200 to 300 miles a day stopping at Route 66 sites, lunch, gas and potty breaks.
