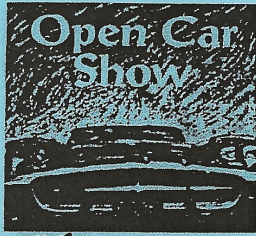
September 8 - COCCC Club meeting, 3 PM Johnnies' in Moore
